2026/103 - Disclosure of Personal Interest

There were no disclosures of personal interest.

2026/104 - Date of May AGM

Cllr Adam Rogers advised Cllrs that both himself and Cllr Eryl O'Neill would be on holiday on the date of the May AGM and proposed that the meeting be moved to a different date. Discussions took place on whether or not the AGM could go ahead without the Chair and Vice Chair, and reference was made to the Standing Orders.

The Executive Officer advised that the AGM could go ahead without the Chair and Vice Chair as per the advice received from One Voices Wales, and that another Cllr could be nominated as Chair until a new Chair is voted in.

Cllr Eryl O'Neill proposed that the date of the AGM be moved to 21st May 2026. This was seconded by Cllr Karen Morgan. An objection was received from Cllr Colin Woodley, which was seconded by Cllr James Woodward. It was agreed that the date of the May AGM would be moved to the 21st May to ensure the availability of key members, with 6 Cllrs voting for, 2 Cllrs voting against and 1 abstention.

2026/105 - Plant and Seed Swap

The Executive Officer provided an update on her efforts to secure plants for the seed swap. It was advised that no update had been received from Cllr Tony Biella. Cllrs agreed to abolish the event, and to offer the wildflower seeds to Rachel's Playhouse and Cylch Meithrin for them to grow with the children. It was agreed that they would be invited to take photos of their efforts which would then be displayed at the Seed Bomb event in the summer. It was agreed that the Environmental Competition would be kept separate to this. **Action 1** – Cllr Zoe Goss to liaise with both playgroups.
